FORESTRY (DECLARATION OF PROTECTED TREES)  
ORDER, 2021

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Forestry Act (*No. 20 of 2010*), makes the following Order —

1. **Citation.**

This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Declaration of Protected Trees) Order, 2021.

2. **Declaration of protected trees.**

The trees specified in Parts I and II of the *Schedule*, are hereby declared protected trees for the purposes of the Act —

**FORESTRY ACT, 2010**

**(NO. 20 OF 2010)**

**FORESTRY (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2021**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Forestry Act, 2010, makes the following Regulations —

**1. Citation.**

These Regulations, which amend the Forestry Regulations, 2014, may be cited as the Forestry (Amendment) Regulations, 2021.

**2. Amendment of Regulation 36 of the principal Regulations.**

Regulation 36 of the principal Regulations is amended by the insertion, immediately after subregulation (3), of the following new subregulation (3A) —

“(3A) The Minister, acting on the advice of the Director of Forestry, may where a hurricane, tornado or any other natural disaster has occurred in any island, islet or cay throughout The Bahamas which causes grave damage to any forest produce or non-forest produce in any designated forest, forest estate, forest reserve, conservation forest or protected forest, reserve the right to make special provision for reduced fees to be payable as specified in the *Second Schedule*, for royalties, permits and licenses for the purpose of these regulations.”.

**3. Amendment to Second Schedule of the principal Regulations.**

The Second Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended —

- (a) by the insertion immediately after the sixth subheading, of the following new schedule subsubheading —  
“REGULATION 36(3) FEES”; and
- (b) by the insertion, immediately beneath the line ending with the words “\$84.00 per ton”, of the following —

**“ROYALTIES AND FEES FOR GRAVELY DAMAGED FOREST  
PRODUCE OR NON-FOREST PRODUCE**

**Regulation 36(3A)**

Saw logs (10 inches/25cms diameter at breast height and greater)	\$5.00/m3/ton
Chip-n-Saw (8-10 inches/20-25cms diameter at breast height)	\$2.00/m3/ton
Pulpwood (8 inches/20cms diameter at breast height)	\$2.00/m3/ton”.
