

Formalizing plans with the Bahamas National Trust

If you plan to visit Inagua National Park during your stay on Inagua, dates should be confirmed with the BNT Inagua or Nassau Office prior to your arrival on Inagua. The Trust will need to know: flight schedule, length of visit, number of persons, etc. Pre-payment to a BNT Office confirms your reservation.

The best time to visit Inagua is from November to June. However, any time you plan to go, you will still see flamingos and other wildlife. During the breeding season (March-May), there are masses of flamingos.

Bahamasair (the National Flag carrier of The Bahamas, has scheduled flights to Matthew Town, Inagua. Flights to Inagua run Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Private charter flights are also available. Arrangements for ground transportation must be made on arrival in Inagua. Trust vehicles are used to transport visitors to the park but other trips to and around Matthew Town must be privately arranged. BNT wardens will be happy to provide recommendations for vehicle rentals. There are no taxis in Inagua.

What you need to bring

Inagua as our southernmost island is almost always sunny and warm. Visitors should be sure and bring sunscreen, a hat, comfortable walking shoes, insect repellent and also any special medication that you might need. Inagua businesses operate on a cash-only basis, your credit cards can be used at the local bank, Bank of The Bahamas, hours are 9:30am – 3pm (Monday to Thursday) and 9:30am – 5 pm (Fridays).
